WHAT IS THE £130 FOR 130TH CAMPAIGN



The £130 for 130th campaign has been created to celebrate 130 years of animal welfare at Newcastle Dog & Cat Shelter and to give supporters simple, flexible ways to get involved throughout a landmark year.

The idea is straightforward: raise £130 in any way that suits you!

The pack is filled with practical fundraising ideas for individuals, schools, community groups and workplaces, alongside a calendar of Shelter events people can take part in, plus other ways to support such as volunteering or regular giving.

Whether someone hosts a small get together, takes on a challenge, joins an event, or rallies friends and colleagues, the aim is to make supporting the Shelter feel achievable, fun and meaningful, while helping provide care, treatment and second chances for dogs and cats in need.

WHAT YOUR DONATION GOES TOWARDS

At Newcastle Dog & Cat Shelter it's important to us that you know where your fundraising efforts go and who they are helping. In 2025, with the help of our generous supporters, we managed to rehome a total of 184 dogs and 293 cats!

£10 – Flea, worm and microchipping for one animal

£20 – One animal vaccinated and checked over by a vet

£130 – Care for an animal for one week: including food, cleaning, exercise, socialisation and enrichment

£1,300 – The cost of an average animal's stay at the shelter
